

How to set up a Dolphin Lounge

Each Lounge will differ based on location, but the basic equipment will be needed. These work very well in many settings; Chiropractic, Reflexology, Dental, Spa, Yoga Studio, Adult Day Care, Hypnotherapy, Naturopath.

The Lounge should be located in a smaller room which comfortably accommodates the equipment and creates a relaxing atmosphere with subdued lighting.

1. A lounger sound bed for about \$2,500 or sound pad for about \$399
2. A comfortable chair for about \$100 plus
3. Insignia 32 inch LCD screen with built in DVD with headphone jack or equal \$260

Note: If TV DVD combo unit does not have a headphone jack you will need advanced knowledge on audio DVD equipment

4. External speakers with subwoofer if intending to offer a sound Lounge without headphones as an option \$25 - \$100
5. 2 splitters \$12
6. Headphones with volume control – price varies (you get what you pay for)
7. Drinking water for clients
8. Drapes or window coverings to block light

As you can see the cost ranges between \$800 and \$3,000 and requires someone familiar with the experience and equipment to attend the Lounge. This could require up to ten minutes per session.

Explaining the process, answering questions and preparing the room are the very basic requirements that, once learned, are easily incorporated into the Lounge setting.

Of course, since our flagship products are on YouTube () a phone or laptop with a speaker on your body will begin the process. Combining the Energy Psychology guided session and then the Water World Dolphin~Whale experience is very powerful and highly recommended to begin a self healing regime. I use the Nexneuro Smart lounge and Sound Oasis Vibroacoustic Therapy System. Either or both of these pieces of equipment can be used in the same room.

The five basic Dolphin DVDs used lounge as described in more detail in another document are available at lounge locations and on line.

The size of room for the setting of the vibroacoustic devise and video screen can vary from a 10 x 10 room to a large waiting room; like a doctor or dentist waiting room. In a waiting room setting, there can be a large flat screen with several Sound Oasis Vibroacoustic Therapy units on comfortable chairs. Also,

custom benches and chairs can be easily built with the proper transducers and a knowledgeable audio engineer. There is a company that will guide you through the process and sells the transducers for any furniture conversion. www.bobybalancesystemonline.com. They are based in Las Vegas.

For **legal purposes** it is best to restrict vibroacoustic sessions for pregnant women, persons with defibrillators and within a few days of a surgical procedure.
